Dear Parents/Carers,

You should now have had confirmation of a place for your children in either Reception, Year 1, Year 6 or Key Worker provision for 22nd June onwards. I have updated our entry/exit protocols to make it clearer as well as adding photographs of the relevant entry/exit points – I hope that this is self-explanatory. It will be sent via e-mail and will also be available on our smartphone app and the website. I will be rearranging the new classrooms for use today and will send photos through so you can see what they will look like. I will also be sending through our Behaviour Policy Addendum for your reference as well as details of school lunch provision for those who would like to take it up. If you are currently receiving the Edenred vouchers from the Government for free school meals, that would cease for any children who come into our provision.

To clarify, as I have had a lot of questions about this: children **DO NOT** need to wear uniform. They must wear **CLEAN**, freshly-laundered clothing that is comfortable. We are ideally spending as much time outside as possible and therefore they should be wearing clothing that allows movement and freedom.

Children can bring their own hand gel and/or moisturiser as necessary: apart from lunches, coats and medication, **nothing else should be brought from home** – no P.E. kits, no book bags, no electronics. Reading will take place with the younger children as it did previously but books will not be sent home and will remain in school to limit any cross-contamination.

We are looking forward to welcoming back those children who are returning and we hope to make their reintegration as smooth as possible.
